Steps to address duplicate kit issues:

- 1. Choose which Kit ID you like best (have one kit represent one body in the match lists)
- 2. Click to EDIT or DELETE your DNA resource profiles

3. Click/Select the radio button in front of the one you choose to delete (or mark as research only) select one kit, and then click either the 'Delete' or 'Edit' button. It may take up to a minute for the delete process to complete.
